

Amendment to H.R. 2792 Offered by Rep. Sewell

This amendment would prohibit the SSI benefit cutoff from taking effect if it would result in loss of benefits for individuals for whom an arrest warrant was issued for nonpayment of court fees, supervision fees, or monetary fines.

Page 2, line 18, before the period, insert “, except that such amendments shall not go into effect unless the Commissioner of Social Security certifies that such amendments would not eliminate supplemental security income benefits for individuals for whom an arrest warrant was issued for nonpayment of court fees, supervision fees, or monetary fines”.
