

Amendment to H.R. 2824 Offered by Rep. DelBene

This amendment would double funding for tribal MIECHV and eliminate the MIECHV cut for states and tribes that do not make required contributions (Section 9).

**AMENDMENT TO THE AMENDMENT IN THE
NATURE OF A SUBSTITUTE TO H.R. 2824
OFFERED BY MS. DELBENE OF WASHINGTON**

Strike section 9 and redesignate section 10 as section 9 (and conform the table of contents accordingly).

At the end of the bill, insert the following (and conform the table of contents accordingly):

1 SEC. 10. ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR INDIAN TRIBES.

2 Section 511(j) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.
3 711(j)) is amended by adding at the end following:

4 “(4) ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR INDIAN
5 TRIBES.—Out of any funds in the Treasury not otherwise
6 appropriated, there are appropriated to the
7 Secretary for purposes of making grants to eligible
8 entities that are Indian Tribes (or a consortium of
9 Indian Tribes), Tribal Organizations, or Urban Indian
10 Organizations, in addition to amounts otherwise
11 reserved for such purposes under paragraph
12 (2)(A), for each of fiscal years 2018 through 2022,
13 \$12,000,000.”
