Such 8 an initiative shall include— 9 (A) a feasibility study on the initiative de-10 scribing how the proposed intervention is based 11 on strong or moderate evidence of effectiveness; 12 (B) a rigorous, third-party evaluation that 13 uses experimental designs employing random 14 assignment when feasible, or quasi-experimental
