A BILL

To amend the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 to inform employers of flexible health insurance benefits.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
- 2 tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,
- 3 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.
- This Act may be cited as the "Small Business Flexi-
- 5 bility Act".

1	SEC. 2. NOTIFICATION OF FLEXIBLE HEALTH INSURANCE
2	BENEFITS.
3	(a) In General.—Subchapter C of chapter 100 of
4	the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 is amended by adding
5	at the end the following new section:
6	"SEC. 9835. NOTIFICATION OF FLEXIBLE HEALTH INSUR-
7	ANCE BENEFITS.
8	"(a) In General.—Not later than 1 year after the
9	date of enactment of this section, the Secretary shall no-
10	tify employers of the availability of tax-advantaged flexible
11	health insurance benefits, with an initial focus on small
12	businesses.
13	"(b) DEFINITIONS.—In this section:
14	"(1) Employer.—The term 'employer' has the
15	meaning given such term in section 3(5) of the Em-
16	ployee Retirement Income Security Act (29 U.S.C.
17	1002(5)).
18	"(2) FLEXIBLE HEALTH INSURANCE BENE-
19	FITS.—The term 'flexible health insurance benefits'
20	means—
21	"(A) an individual contribution health re-
22	imbursement arrangement (as described in the
23	rule entitled 'Health Reimbursement Arrange-
24	ments and Other Account-Based Group Health
25	Plans' (84 Fed. Reg. 28888 (June 20, 2019));

1	"(B) a qualified small employer health re-
2	imbursement arrangement (as defined in sec-
3	tion $9831(d)(2)$; or
4	"(C) the small employer health insurance
5	credit.".
6	(b) CLERICAL AMENDMENT.—The table of sections
7	for subchapter C of chapter 100 of such Code is amended
8	by adding at the end the following new item:
	"Sec. 9835. Notification of flexible health insurance benefits.".
