## A BILL

To extend reemployment services and eligibility assessments to all claimants for unemployment benefits, and for other purposes.

1 *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-*  
2 *tives of the United States of America in Congress assembled,*

3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “Building on Reemploy-  
5 ment Improvements to Deliver Good Employment for  
6 Workers Act” or the “BRIDGE for Workers Act”.

7 **SEC. 2. ELIGIBILITY FOR REEMPLOYMENT SERVICES.**

8 Section 306(a) of the Social Security Act (42 U.S.C.  
9 506(a)) is amended—

1           (1) by striking “individuals referred to reem-  
2           ployment services as described in section 303(j)”  
3           and inserting “claimants for unemployment com-  
4           pensation, including claimants referred to reemploy-  
5           ment services as described in section 303(j),”; and

6           (2) by striking “such individuals” and inserting  
7           “such claimants”.
